

# Minimum system Requirements

## Exchange Online - Lync Online - SharePoint Online

There are important technical elements determining the success of an Office 365 migration. The most important technical elements are:

1. Internet Connection: When dealing with the cloud, a high speed internet speed connection is important and recommended to receive the full experience of office 365, however it is not necessary and the software will still run but at a slower pace.
2. Operating Systems: The below information provides full detail of the minimum operating systems.
3. Browser Software: When accessing Office 365 it is recommended that you have the latest browser. The information below provides the minimum browser requirements.
4. Office Clients: To take advantage of all the latest features available in Exchange, Lync and SharePoint and for maximum performance, it is recommended that you use the latest Office Client (Office 2013). However, the information below provides the minimum Office client requirements for connectivity to Exchange, SharePoint and Lync Online.
